



Fall 2019 High School Athletics Registration Procedure



ATHLETIC AWARENESS/PRESEASON MEETING NIGHT: Athletes and Parents are expected to attend

- **North: Tuesday August 13, 2019 5:00– 8:00pm**
- **South: Wednesday August 14 5:00– 8:00pm**

At the **high school level** there are 5 steps to clear an athlete for participation:

Step 1 = online registration – please see the next few pages for instructions

- In order to be cleared through the remaining 4 steps before the first day of tryouts please register at least 5 days prior to the start of your season.
- Students may be registered after this deadline but in most circumstances **will NOT be cleared** to play by the first day of tryouts/practice.
- Registration will close the first day of tryouts/practice

Step 2 = a physical must be turned in once during a student’s high school career.

- For the 2019-20 school year, any new physicals must be dated on or after July 1, 2018.
- Any freshmen, transfer student, and student new to high school athletics **MUST** submit this physical prior to any participation.
- This physical should be turned in to the school’s athletics office. NORTH E104/SOUTH C1001
- This physical should **NOT** be turned in to the school nurse, guidance, or an academy office.

Step 3 = academic eligibility

- Students must maintain a C- overall average and have no more than one non-passing grade during the previous marking period in order to be eligible to participate in school athletics. For fall sports – June 2019 Q4/S2/FY final grades are used for eligibility.
- All freshmen are declared academically eligible for the fall season.
- Please refer to Nashua School District policy JJA for additional information.

Step 4 = Impact Concussion Testing

- All freshmen, juniors, transfer students, and students new to high school athletics participating in a contact sport **MUST** take this cognitive baseline test **PRIOR** to participating in school athletics. Cross Country and Golf are excluded in the fall.
- Impact testing sessions will occur at the Preseason Meeting Nights.

Step 5 = Athletic user fee payment

- The fee can be paid online during online registration in step 1.
- The fee can be paid by check or cash in the athletic office at each high school. NORTH E104/SOUTH C1001
- The fee can also be paid at the Preseason Meeting Nights on August 13th or 14th
- User fees will be refunded only under these circumstances:
 - Student-athlete tries out but is cut from the team (full refund).
 - Student-athlete suffers a season-ending injury with more than half the season remaining (50% refund).
- User fees must be paid (or payment plans established) prior to a student receiving a uniform and competing in the first contest.

PLEASE complete online registration early to allow time for the remainder of the process to occur prior to first day of tryouts/practice.

Instructions for Registering Online through FamilyID

It is expected that online registration process will be completed by a parent/guardian.

Two important terms to know through the process:

Program = school and season

Section = specific sport within that school and season

ARE YOU NEW TO FAMILYID?

If you are signing up with FamilyID for the first time:

You will enter your name, email address, and select a password.

Click "I agree to FamilyID Terms of Service" and click CREATE ACCOUNT. If you do not have an email address, free and accessible emails are available at websites such as hotmail.com, gmail.com, and yahoo.com.

This step DOES NOT register your son/daughter for athletics. This only sets up your family's account.

At this point you will get an email that you must open and click the link to confirm your account and continue the registration process by logging in.

After confirming your account through that email address you will be able to register your son/daughter for athletics. This part of the process is very straightforward. Be sure to read all sections of the agreement which includes important information regarding other paperwork and eligibility requirements.

HAVE A FAMILYID ACCOUNT ALREADY?

Go to <https://www.familyid.com/nashua-school-district-athletics> there is also a link from your school's new athletic website.

Click LOG IN in the upper right corner.

Enter email and password – click LOG IN (if you forgot your password there is a forgot password? Link)

If you do not see the **Nashua School District Athletics** link type "NASHUA" in the box where it says "Type organization name or keyword to find a program" and click Find.

This will bring up all 5 programs in Nashua – choose the appropriate school for your child.

- Middle School – ELM STREET – Fall 2019
- Middle School – FAIRGROUNDS – Fall 2019
- Middle School – PENNICHUCK – Fall 2019

Registration for all Fall sports will open on June 1, 2019
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The registration process from here is very straightforward. Read through and complete each section. See the next page for a detailed description of each part.

Please note that online registration is only the first step of the process to clear your child for participation in interscholastic athletics.
